



INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

In the case of inclement weather, Notre Dame Academy uses the following procedures:

- ◆ When Loudoun County Public Schools are closed for the day, Notre Dame Academy is closed for the day and no activities or practices are held. The Head of School may grant exceptions on a case-by-case basis.
- ◆ When Loudoun County Public Schools are delayed one or two hours, Notre Dame Academy is delayed one or two hours. ***However, the Virginia Regional Transit Association buses that serve Notre Dame Academy will run at the regularly scheduled times.***
- ◆ When Loudoun County Public Schools have early dismissal, Notre Dame Academy will make its own decision.
- ◆ When Notre Dame Academy is scheduled to be open and Loudoun County Public Schools are scheduled to be closed in advance, families should check Notre Dame Academy's website or Edline for further information.

Notre Dame Academy will always post our emergency closing and delay information on our websites (including Edline), on local television and radio stations, and send notification to all email addresses registered through Edline. The radio stations are WTOP, WINC, and WAGE. The television stations are channels 4, 5, 7 and 9.

The decision to close or delay school is primarily based on the road conditions at campus and in western Loudoun County. Because our students commute from many different areas surrounding Middleburg, parents should exercise their own judgment concerning road conditions from their home to school. If a parent feels that the conditions in their area are too hazardous for commuting, they are requested to please contact the school to inform the Registrar's Office of the situation. Students who miss school during hazardous weather conditions will be considered excused and the student will not be penalized.
