## **COURSE SELECTION FOR 2008-2009 BEGINS MARCH 20 ON EDLINE**

Beginning on Thursday, March 20, the Course Selection Guide will be available on Edline and the Notre Dame Academy website. Course selection season will begin on Thursday, March 20 and ends Sunday, April 13. Students should carefully review this course selection guide, discuss their choices with their parents, and consult with their guidance counselor if needed in order to choose the seven credits they will need next year. Once they have decided on their classes, each student should log onto [Edline](#) and submit their choices. Please remember that all students are required to take seven credit hours each year.

All students will also have an opportunity to review their choices online with the Guidance Department during the online registration period. They will fill out additional paperwork at this time to specify their second and third choices for electives, should their first choice not be available. Please keep in mind that some courses offered in this guide may be limited by class size and faculty availability. Most courses are scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis based on the date of scheduling fee payment. Especially in the case of electives, it is strongly recommended that you select several alternate courses in case your first elective choice is unavailable.
